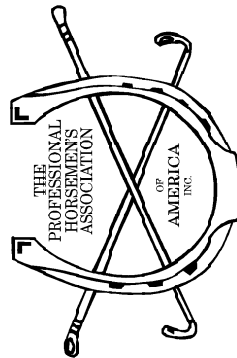

Entries must be received with full payment by October 8, 2015.

There is a 5% surcharge for using a credit card. Credit cards will be charged when entries are accepted. VISA or MASTERCARD Only.

The management reserves the right to change the order of classes before or during the show.

All prize money will be paid by check in the show office.

There will be a \$50 surcharge added to all checks returned by the bank or credit cards that are denied.

After the closing date there will be NO REFUNDS on entries unless your position can be filled by another horse.

The show manager and management take no responsibility for loss, injury or damage to horses, exhibitors, equipment and anyone connected thereto.

Every horse will be charged a \$20.00 EMT/Insurance fee per rider.

All Dogs Must Be Restrained At All Times. Dogs are permitted in the show ring or the stable areas only.

Medal Classes: The initial test will be built into the course. Further testing at the discretion of the judges. All courses will consist of at least 8 jumping efforts at the stated height.

Hunter Classes: All classes will be judged on an open numerical scoring system. All courses will consist of at least 8 jumping efforts at the stated height.

If any division is not filled after the closing date, Chapters will be asked send additional entries for that division until the maximum number of entries is reached.

Schedule: Classes Will Run In Numerical Order

All Equitation - Saturday - Starting at 8:00 AM

All Hunters - Sunday - Starting at 8:00 AM

Horses will be permitted to hack in the show arena each morning, but all schooling will be in the indoor schooling arena and/or outdoor ring, weather permitting.
